3. Sometimes you can join two words into one by using an **apostrophe**. This is called a **contraction**. Write these examples from the story in their full form. The first one is done for you.

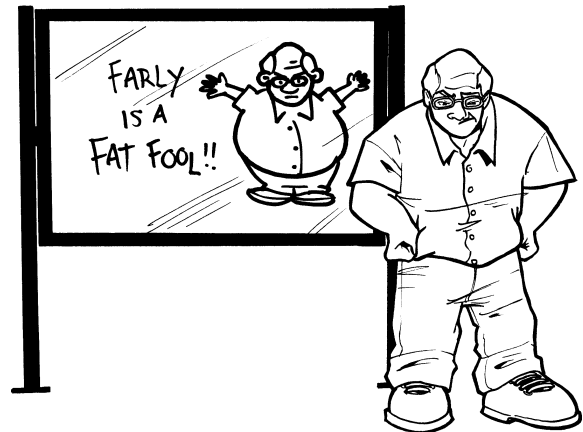
