Capital Letters

A quick reminder:

In our writing, we show each new sentence by making the first letter of the first word into a **capital letter**.

Here are some examples:

Morgan was angry and trying hard not to cry.

"It's not fair!" she said.

Gran smoothed the bed cover.

"What's wrong, love?" she asked.

"Katie is my friend but she doesn't want to play.

*She just wants to watch baby James. Everyone
comes just to see him. Why do we need a baby, anyway?"*

The rules of capital letters

Rule 1: Every sentence must start with a capital letter. This shows the *beginning* of a sentence.

For example:

Morgan was angry and trying hard not to cry.

Rule 2: All proper nouns (the names of people and places) must have a capital letter. For example:

Morgan didn't answer her Gran. She remembered how much fun she had with Mum and Dad before James was born.

We love to visit Queensland to see the Great Barrier Reef.

Rule 3: The pronoun I must always have a capital letter.

"I don't think I've ever told you what your mother said when Uncle Ian
She wanted to exchange him for a pet rabbit."

"I don't believe you, Gran."

"It's true, I think we're always envious of new babies."



EXERCISE 1

Here is another passage from the story *The Big Sister*. However, the capitals have been removed. Can you circle the letters that should be capitals?
