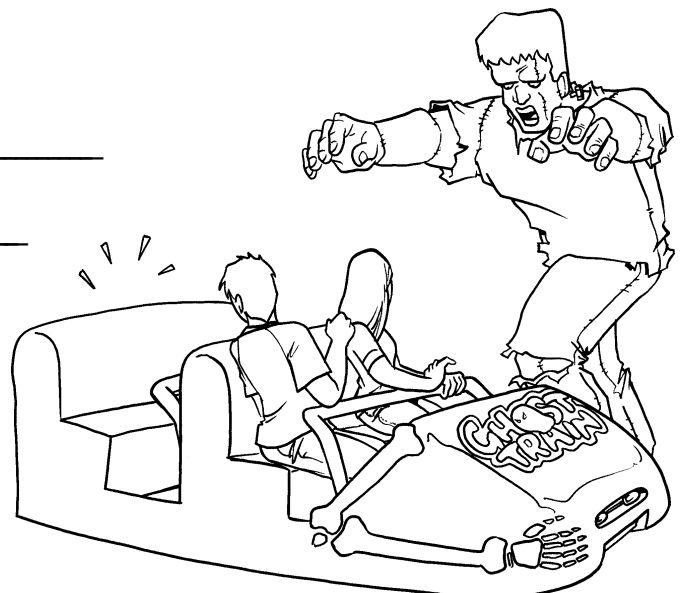
The Ghost Train

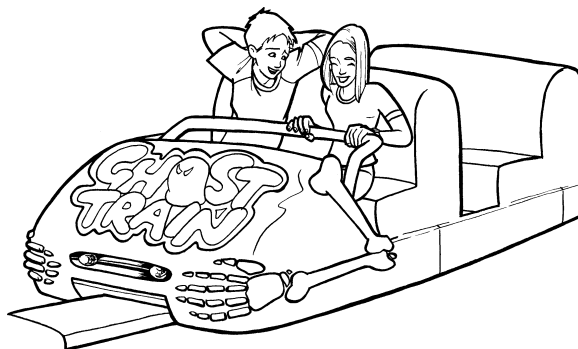
