## **Types of Words**

Now you have read "The Case of the Fancy Dress Fiend", can you work on the words in the story?

You will remember that words come in different types. The most common are **nouns** (the names of things), **verbs** (words for actions) and **adjectives** (describing words). Here is an example:

My pet cat (noun) thinks (verb) sardines are delicious (adjective).
